Contenido:

This course will begin with an overview of the legal system in the United States, particularly with respect to the country's Constitution and theories of constitutional interpretation. Then each week it will dive into a new---and often controversial---topic in modern constitutional law in the United States. Topics that will be covered include: the scope of the federal government's power; the Second Amendment right to bear arms; the amount of protection against discrimination based on race, gender, and sexual orientation; the First Amendment and limitations on political spending; the government taking of private property; the sentencing of juveniles under the Eighth Amendment; and others. This course will be offered in English and students will be expected to participate in and lead class discussions.
