<a href="#">Applied Ethics</a>	In the minor in Applied Ethics you will be able to deepen your capacity for analysis and reflection and propose solutions to conflictive situations that require guiding ethical criteria.
<a href="#">Art and Creativity</a>	You will develop innovative, reflective professional practices, close to sensitivity, with a critical sense, and social responsibility.
<a href="#">Contemporary History</a>	In the minor in Contemporary History you will learn about the historical processes that shaped contemporaneity from political, economic, social, artistic and thought approaches.
<a href="#">Criminology</a>	The minor in Criminology will allow you to enhance your professional profile through a combination of courses in criminology, public security and related disciplines, such as Law, psychology and social sciences.
